### **POSTER SPECIFICATIONS**

- Must only use 8.5" x 11 or 9" x 12"paper; any color.
- Theme of poster must be PATRIOTISM; or WHAT IT MEANS TO BE AN AMERICAN
- On the back page, bottom left corner, it **MUST** include:
  - 1. School
  - 2. Teacher's Name
  - 3. Student's First and Last Name
  - 4. Grade Level

#### **DUE DATE**

Posters must arrive at the District Office by Wednesday, September 6, 2017.



There should only be ONE-POSTER-PER-GRADE (total of 4 posters) sent to the District Office by each school.

#### **General Information**

- 1. A team of educators, police, fire & veterans will judge all submissions from RUSD schools by grade level.
- 2. <u>Each grade level</u> will have a "district level" winner (One winner for K, one for 1<sup>st</sup>, one for 2<sup>nd</sup>, one for 3<sup>rd</sup>).
- 3. District Level winners will be announced at the Sunday, September 11<sup>th</sup> Patriot Day Celebration.
- 4. Grand Prize Winners will receive \$100 cash at a school board meeting following Patriot Day
- 5. All district-level winners will receive \$50 gift cards or cash at RUSD school board meeting.
